Equipment Maintenance:

- Generator Testing - Monthly
- HVAC Inspections - Annually
- Vehicles - Daily
- Sprinkler systems – Quarterly
- Power Tools – Prior to Each Use

Building Maintenance:

- Know Where the Water Shut-Off is Located and How to Turn the Water Off
- Preventing Frozen Pipes – Insulation, Heaters
- Thawing Frozen Pipes – Keep Faucet Open, Apply Heat
- Vacant Buildings
