Question 1: In **Section 3.1, Item 7:** “If the Texas Division of Workers’ Compensation issues a penalty for late, inaccurate, or missing FROI/SROI transmission because of Company’s failure to submit the transmission to the Texas DWC, Company will cover all costs associated with the penalty.”

Would TML be agreeable to adding the word “*solely*” before “*because of Company’s failure to submit*”
